Norfolk Design Awards

Royster Building

NRHA and Glenn & Sadler Engineers and Architects were awarded the first annual Wilbur Marshall Award for Excellence in Engineering and Design for the work done on the facade of the historic Royster Building, NRHA's main office at 201 Granby Street. The engineering design of the facade work ensured the preservation of the building, Norfolk's first downtown skyscraper, constructed in the Neo-Classic style during an 11-month period in 1911-1912.

Calvert Square

A City of Norfolk Design Award was presented to NRHA, Siska/Aurand Landscape Architects, and Calvert Square Advisory Council for their successful transformation of the Calvert Square public housing community. The Norfolk Design Review Committee applauded the efforts made in Calvert Square and noted that the improvements have enhanced the neighborhood and surrounding community, in addition to improving the lifestyle of residents.
